Mr. Braud moved, seconded by Mr. Lusk, that the Bedford County Economic Development Authority go into Closed Session pursuant to Section 2.2-3711 (A)(3) and (5), for discussion or consideration of the acquisition or disposition of real property for a public purpose, where discussion in an open meeting would adversely affect the bargaining position or negotiating strategy of the public body; and for discussion or consideration of a prospective business or industry or the expansion of an existing business or industry where no previous announcement has been made of the businesses' or industry's interest in location or expanding its facilities in the community, as it pertains to Lot 1 in the New London Business and Technology Center. The EDA was unanimous in allowing Mr. Messier and Mr. Bailey to sit in on the closed session.
